Enrolment Policy

1. A completed enrolment form/order form must be accompanied by payment in full.
2. 3. Applicants must fully complete their enrolment forms. The ACCA registration number and Date of Birth are two mandatory information fields for Kaplan's assessment of your eligibility for enrolments and keep tracking of your future performances at the professional examinations. Please note that law enforcement officers have their full authorities for searching and checking with your personal data / identifications documents that you have entrusted for our custody, in the event of their conducting any necessary investigations. Therefore, a fully completed enrollment form is of a primordial protection and proof for your proper student status at Kaplan.

Course Materials for Online courses

1. The online course and/or eLearning logins, course materials, and access to live online courses (if applicable), or lecture videos recordings provided to the student will be for his/her own use only. 2. Course notes will only be available as printable soft copies for online courses. Students can access and download the notes from the eLearning platform to print them as needed.

Late applications will not be accepted and HK\$150 will be charged for each successful issuance. The Certificate of Attendance will be ready within 14 working days after our acceptance of certificate request.

eLearning Platform

1. Login information will be emailed to users 2-3 working days prior to course commencement; or within 5 working days after the enrolment is processed if the course has started, whichever is later.
2. For security purposes, a unique One-Time Password (OTP) will be sent to your email address each time you log in to the eLearning platform. We are unable to resolve issues such as delay, or non-receipt of OTP related to the third-party email providers.
3. Kaplan does not warrant that eLearning Online Access will be uninterrupted or error-free. Online Access to Kaplan eLearning is provided on an "as is, as available" basis. By using Kaplan's eLearning platform, you confirm that you have met the minimum system requirements and are fully satisfied with the playback performance of Kaplan eLearning.
