What is ACT?

The ACT is a standardized test for high school achievement and college admissions in the United States. Admission by ACT Inc., the ACT is a paper-based test and consists of five subject areas: English, Mathematics, Reading, Science and Writing (the essay section is optional).

The majority of the four-year colleges and universities in the U.S. accept the ACT but institutions place different emphasis on standardized tests in comparison to other methods of evaluation, such as class rank, GPA, and extracurricular activities. The main four sections of the ACT are scored individually on a scale of 1 - 36, and a composite score is provided


