The Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) is required by almost all MBA programs. The GMAT is a computer - adaptive test designed to provide a common yardstick by which business school admissions committees can measure applicants and their ability to succeed in their MBA programs. (Validity: 5 years)
